1 EXPECTATIONS OF BEHAVIOUR IN OUR CHURCH COMMUNITY

Jesus told us to love one another as he loves us. As Christians we know our life together is strengthened when our behavior is consistent with our faith. However, our experience of being together can be difficult, particularly when there are differences. So, it is important to be clear about how we will behave towards each other.

2 BEING A COMMUNITY

- 2.1 We will value the wellbeing and safety of others, particularly children and other vulnerable people
- 2.2 We will encourage each other to participate in the life of the church
- 2.3 We will consider the impact of our behavior on others.

3 RELATING TO EACH OTHER

- 3.1 We will guard the safety of all, especially children and other vulnerable people.
- 3.2 We will treat each other with respect and dignity, irrespective of ability, gender, sexuality, race, age or contribution to the church.
- 3.3 We will act with integrity and honesty in our interactions with each other.

4 COMMUNICATING WITH EACH OTHER

- 4.1 We will communicate respectfully with others, and not in a way that threatens, belittles or humiliates.
- 4.2 We will speak with integrity and honesty, and refrain from speculation and gossip

5 ACKNOWLEDGING DIFFERENCE

- 5.1 We will respect those who are different from us as not isolate or ridicule them.
- 5.2 We will listen to and seek to understand the beliefs, opinions and practices of others, even when we do not share their views.

6 RESPONDING TO CONFLICT

- 6.1 We will accept responsibility for our part in a conflict.
- 6.2 We will be willing to play our part in resolving conflict.

Genesis 1:20-21

"And God said, "Let the waters bring forth swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the expanse of the heavens." So God created the great sea creatures and every living creature that moves, with which the waters swarm, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

Proverbs 12:10

"Whoever is righteous has regard for the life of his beast, but the mercy of the wicked is cruel."

Job 12:7-10

"But ask the beasts, and they will teach you; the birds of the heavens, and they will tell you; or the bushes of the earth, and they will teach you; and the fish of the sea will declare to you. Who among all these does not know that the hand of the Lord has done this? In his hand is the life of every living thing and the breath of all mankind."
